ALL FOOD PANTRY CLIENTS ARE MONITORED USING THE EFFORTS TO OUTCOMES DATA MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (ETO, SOCIAL SOLUTIONS, INC.)

SANCTION OUTREACH: OUTREACH AND CASE MANAGEMENT ASSISTANCE TO INDIVIDUALS WHO HAVE BEEN SANCTIONED BY WORKFIRST NJ (WFNJ) FOR NON COMPLIANCE. PROGRAM STAFF MAKE CONTACT WITH SACTIONED INDIVIDUALS AND PROVIDES SUPPORT TO GET THEM BACK INTO COMPLIANCE AND PARTICIPATING IN WFNJ ACTIVITIES. IN 2015, THE PROGRAM SERVED 2,002 INDIVIDUALS THROUGH PHONE CALLS AND HOME VISITS IN PASSAIC AND BERGEN COUNTY.
