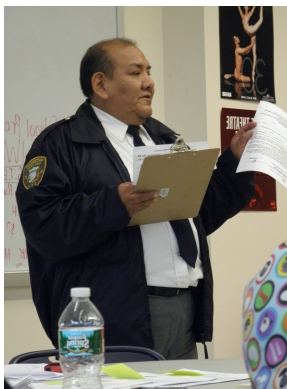
# Top-Performing Students Celebrate at Fall Fest
